

Camping Regulations

Northern Territory

In order to maintain these spots, we urge tourists to please camp **ONLY** in the dedicated tourist/camping parks and/or the structured campsites and do not set up your camp along the road, up a track or over a sandhill.

Please see the **TRAFFIC REGULATIONS 1999**

Section 34 - Person or thing obstructing road

(1) **A person must not enter or remain on a road** (unless with the permission of the competent authority for the road) **for the purpose of:**

(b) erecting a structure; or

(d) **camping.**

(2) An authorised person may give a direction to a person who is contravening sub regulation (1) to leave the road or to remove a thing from the road.

(5) In this regulation: road includes a road-related area.

The Australian Road Rules – Rule 13 provides a clear definition on a road related area.

13 What is a road-related area

(1) A road-related area is any of the following:

(a) an area that divides a road;

(b) a footpath or nature strip adjacent to a road;

(c) an area that is not a road and that is open to the public and designated for use by cyclists or animals;

(d) an area that is not a road and that is open to or used by the public for driving, riding or parking vehicles.
